During her Ph.D, she had the opportunity to spend one year at the Animal Genomics and Improvement Lab at ARS-USDA, Beltsville, USA, which allowed her to become familiar with the US dairy genetic evaluation. In June of 2018, Tatiane joined the Centre for Genetic Improvement of Livestock (CGIL), University of Guelph, Canada as a Post-Doctoral Fellow. She has a strong background in quantitative genetics and genomics in livestock animals. Throughout her career, she has gained experience in defining models for genetic evaluation and worked with large datasets, including genotype and sequence data.
